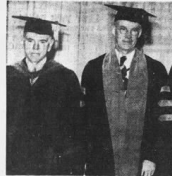

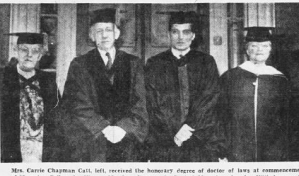
Israel Siskind Sentenced at Easton—Allentown Man Gets 8 to 16 Months for Forgery

A total of 1,200 students from Northampton county were conferred on at the annual commencement exercises of Pennsylvania State University in University Park, Pa., Monday morning.

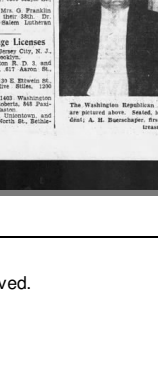

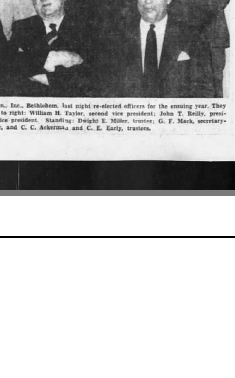
